The Sea Dog Worlds were completed on December 14 with 26 boats sailing (at least part of the time). Ten came from Sachem's Head. The wind was out of the South and was gusting well into the 20s for most of the seven races. The gusts were challenging to say the least and a premium was put on keeping the boats moving. Most racers were displaying their bailing skills during and between races. Other than that, the weather was delightful. Morgan Paxhia ran away with the competition with four firsts and only 16 points. Laura was not far behind with 25 and Peter had 35 for third. Seventeen boats finished the final race. These results will not be counted toward the Fall season.
