

Sea Dog Fleet 166 Scoring 2008-2009

For the 2008-2009 Season, scoring will be unchanged from 2007-2008. Here are the salient points:

1. The racing will start promptly at 1 p.m. on Sundays with as many races as possible per Race Day. Normally races will not be started after 3:30 p.m., but that will be up to the discretion of the RC.
2. A day will qualify as a race day if three or more races are sailed.
3. A boat will be considered an "entrant" for a Race Day if he/she ranks as a starter in at least one race.
4. There will be no daily throwouts. Low point scoring will be used (RRS, Appendix A). Note that according to that system (A4.2) DNC, DNS, DNF, DSQ, are all scored the number of entrants for the day plus one. E.g., if you DNF with daily 10 entrants you get 11 points for that race.
5. The finishing place for the Day will be used Series Score. There is no qualifying requirement for the Series. There will be one throwout for every three race days and non-participants will receive one point more than the number of entrants for that Race Day. For example, if there are 10 Race Days, there are three throwouts. If you sail on only six days, you count your best seven scores (which would count at least one Race Day in which you did not participate).
6. No adjustments will be made to scores (breakdown points, redress points, etc.) except as allowed in A6 of the RRS (Changes in Places and Scores of Other Boats).
7. Sailors who take on RC duties for a day get a first place for the day, but they can only receive one such first place for a given Season Series. Note that this means any given Race Day of the Series may have more than one first place finisher.
8. The Fall Season will run from November 9 through January 18 (ten race dates, racing on December 21, but not on December 28).
9. New Years Day (Thursday) will be a standalone race (the Hangover Bowl).
10. The Spring Season will run from January 25 to April 5 (11 race dates, no racing Easter, April 12).

Note: If these scoring rules need minor tweaks (or if it does not reflect the minutes of the AGM), please bring proposed changes to the attention of Chuck or Nelson.
